

CPANS Frank Kloiber Memorial Scholarship – Research

The CPANS Annual Scholarship recognizes outstanding individuals in the CPANS region (Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Nunavut, and the Northwest Territories) who excel in academic achievement and research progress. The scholarship awards \$1,000 to a PhD student and \$500 to a MSc student.

CPANS is committed to fostering a safe, inclusive, and sustainable future while reflecting the diversity of the communities it serves. Recognizing that individuals from underrepresented groups often hesitate to apply, CPANS strongly encourages applications from these groups.

If you would like to be involved with CPANS, check out your local student chapter for more opportunities.

Eligibility Criteria

- Must hold an AWMA membership
- Be registered in full-time studies in a post-secondary institution within CPANS region, pursuing a PhD or MSc program.
- Have completed the first year of their graduate studies with a GPA of greater than 3.5.
- Applicants who have graduated within one year of the award closing date are also eligible.

Selection Process

Selection committee members will evaluate applicants based on their written submission, proof of enrollment or graduation, one reference, and resume.

- Student must demonstrate how their studies and research contribute to improving air quality, waste management practices, or related environmental challenges.
- Proof of enrollment must be from the institution of studies (e.g., confirmation of registration with university logo, a letter on an official university letter head, etc)
- Transcript must be issued from the institution of studies (e.g., Unofficial transcript, Official transcript)

Application Process

- Email your complete application package to cpans.scholarship@gmail.com. Incomplete submissions, including missing documents, will result in the application being voided.
- Name all files using the format: "Last name_First name_Research_File name". For example:
 Lee_June_Research_Application Form.
- Submit with the application:
 - o A completed application form.
 - o Complete Academic CV.
 - o Transcript issued from the University
 - o Proof of active student status or proof of graduation within the past year.
 - o Essay response (Format: maximum 750 words, Arial font, size 11, spacing 1.5)

- Closing Date: March 30, 2026
- Award Presentation: The scholarship will be presented during the 2026 CPANS Conference in Calgary. The award winner will also be contacted via email.
